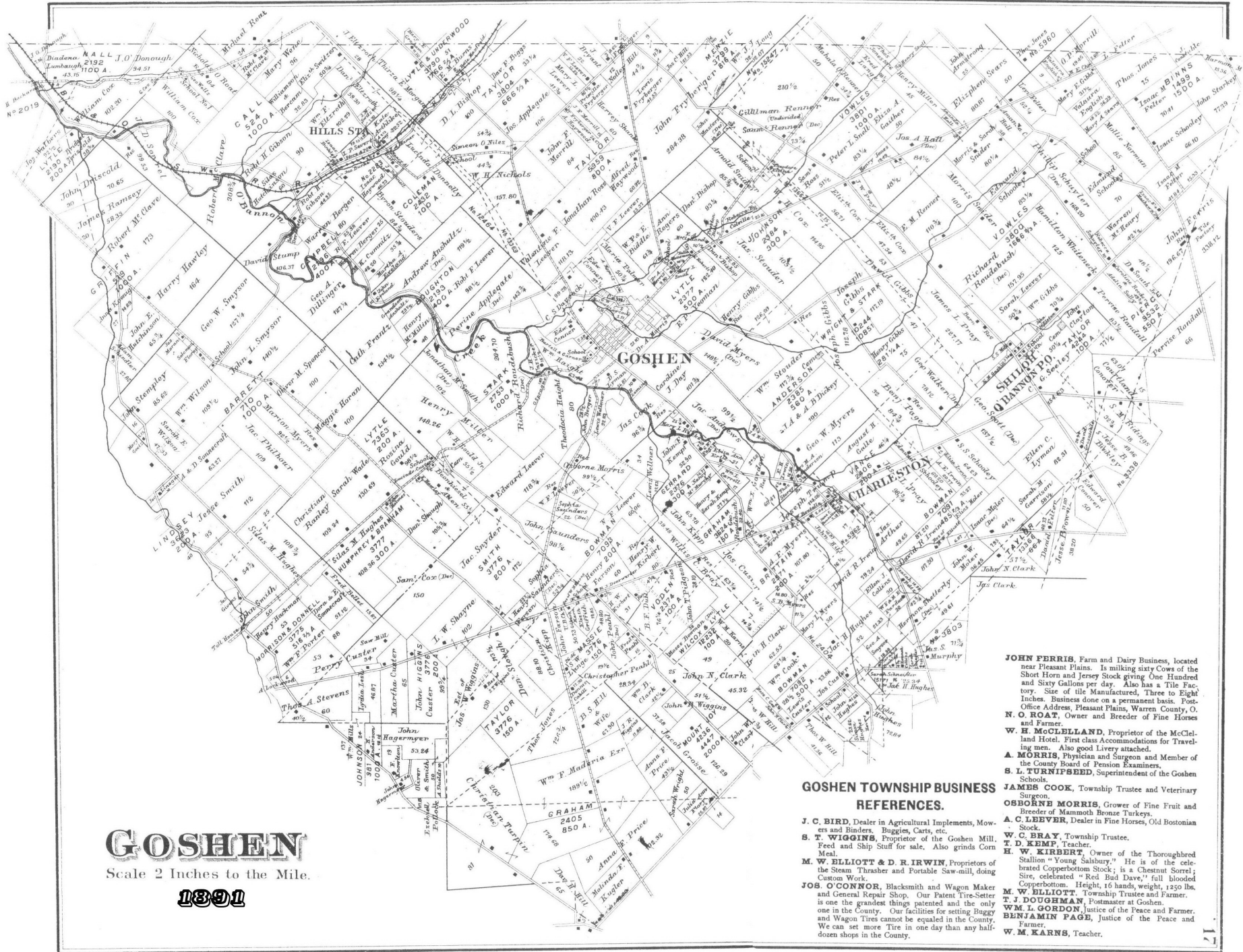


# Clermont County Genealogical Society
