When founded in 1845, Baldwin-Wallace College was one of the first colleges in Ohio to admit students without regard to race or gender. That spirit of inclusiveness has flourished and evolved into a personalized approach to education: one that stresses individual growth as students learn to learn, respond to new ideas, adapt to new situations and prepare for the certainty of change.

Founder John Baldwin would have been pleased to watch the institution he founded grow and develop, be strengthened through a merger with neighboring German Wallace College in 1913, and assume its position of prominence while serving the people of the region.
