Dr. Robert Reedy was an Optometrist. He was a charter member of St. James Methodist Church, a member of the Ohio State Optometrist's Association, and Toledo Lodge, F&AM. His hobby was bowling. It is said he was a very nice and kind man. He always asked the blessing before meals. He frequently would say "Make me a blessing to someone today." He was an extremely neat person, always having every hair on his head in place. Before leaving the house he would always kiss Sophia good-bye.






