Editor and Publisher of Cadiz Republican


Was born on a farm in Jefferson County, Ohio, but has fived in Cadiz ever since he was nine years of age. He learned the printing trade in the Cadiz Sentinel office, when the late Charles N. Allen was the publisher of that paper, and served as Foreman in the Cadiz Republican office for one

while; also worked in a book printing office in Boston, Massachusetts. Later he taught school for a number of years, two winter terms in country districts, and the rest of the time in Cadiz. He bought the office of The Cadiz Republican in April, 1869, and has been the publisher of the paper since that time. He served as a member of the Ohio Legislature in House of Representatives, in the t General Assembly, for the years 18 1891. The Cadiz Republican, unhis management, has had a circulat in recent years of from 2,900 to 3,100 copies, weekly.






JOHN T. TIMMONS
