RESEARCH COMMITTEE GUIDELINES

For some time we have needed a guideline for doing research for our members. The Board of Trustees has formulated the following instructions and guides:

The Richland County Genealogical Society will provide limited research in the Ohio Genealogical Society Library for both members and non members. This will be done by volunteers, free, for no longer than one hour spent on each request. Of course a self-addressed stamped envelope (SASE) should accompany each request and the inquirer must pay for any copying.

Somewhat more extensive research, up to three hours, may be done for a fee of \$5.00 per hour, payable to the society, dependent upon the availability and willingness of a volunteer. Limited courthouse research would also require this fee, plus copying costs there.

Each request should be as specific as possible, and preferable for only one surname. We cannot undertake analysis and organization of data. Questions should relate to Richland County.

Requests will normally be answered in the order received, but in the event of a backlog simpler inquiries and requests from members will be attended to first.

A form will be completed to keep a record of requests received and answered. Letters with family information will then be filed in the Richland County room at OGS.

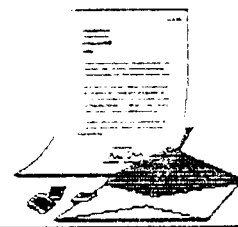

LEGAL NOTICES FROM THE MANSFIELD GAZETTE - 1828-1831

We are fortunate to have the actual copies of the *Mansfield Gazette and Richland County Farmer* in the Ohio Genealogical Society Library. From them we are gleaning the legal notices: divorces, estates, partitions, etc. Included are some from Crawford County, Ohio. They evidently did not have a paper at that time and, being required by law to publish them, perhaps a Richland Co. paper was the nearest. (see illustration). The last date is that of the issue where the article was found.

LADIES - IT WAS A BATTLE BUT WE WON THE VOTE!

In a letter, dated April 23, 1869, to the *Mansfield Herald*, published on Thursday, May 27, 1869, Senator John Sherman wrote as follows:

"I have always favored the most liberal laws for "Woman's Rights." so far as property, business, employment, liberty, and social position are concerned. In these respects they ought to stand on the same footing as men; but I have seen no reason to convince me that they would be better off or that society would be improved by their having the right to vote.

My fear is that the right to vote would tend to disturb the harmony of society, make discord in the family, and thus cause much greater evil than good."

NOTE: To those of you who do not live in the Richland Co. OH area--John Sherman was the brother of General William Tecumseh Sherman. He was an attorney, a member of the U. S. Senate and Treasurer of the United States. He served in the Civil War, raising the Sherman Brigade. When Lincoln was shot, Sherman was in the audience. His memorial in Mansfield, is the beautiful gate that is at the entrance to Brinkerhoff Avenue, at Park Avenue West. It was placed there, for he gave land for the park system in Mansfield, this includes South Park on Brinkerhoff Avenue.
