The Richland County-Shelby Chapter is selling "**Shelby Oakland Cemetery and Most Pure Heart of Mary Catholic Cemetery Records**." This 288 page hardbound book contains approximately 12,000 burials, maps, and an every-name index. Records begin in the early 1800s up to December 31, 1988. Records were taken from tombstones, burial permits, and the cemetery ledger book. The books will be available in mid-January. James **SIRPLISS**, of Washington Twp., an old and respect citizen, was buried last week. He was born in Washington Co. PA on March 30th, 1794 and came to this county (Richland) in 1815. He built his cabin near the present village of Washington, and resided there to the time of his death. In 1816, he returned to Pennsylvania and married Miss Mary **Flora**. After the death of his first wife in 1849, he married Martha **McBride**. June 5, 1878

Samuel **RITTER** died on his homestead farm near Mansfield on June 2d, 1878, aged 64 years and 18 days. Mr. Ritter was born in Franklin Co. PA on May 14th, 1814; came to Ohio and settled first in Wayne Co., but soon removed to Richland on a farm near Lexington. June 12, 1878

Died at her residence, on East Market St., Mansfield, Thursday, Oct 3d, 1878, Mrs. Catharine **McCULLOUGH**. She was born in Franklin Co.
