The Richland County-Shelby Chapter is selling "Shelby Oakland Cemetery and Most Pure Heart of Mary Catholic Cemetery Records." This 288 page hardbound book contains approximately 12,000 burials, maps, and an every-name index. Records begin in the early 1800s up to December 31, 1988. Records were taken from tombstones, burial permits, and the cemetery ledger book. The books will be available in mid-January. Robert S. McFarland and Mary Ellen Ford were united in marriage on the 12th day of March in the year of our Lord 1857 by the Rev. A. K. Owen. (Vol. 7, page 399 of the Richland County OH marriage records)

Robert S. McFarland and Mary Jane McBride were united in marriage on the 26th day of November in the year of our Lord 1863 by the Rev. J. W. Redding. (Vol. 8, page 736 of the Richland County OH marriage records)
