They are pictures taken of my grandmother, mother, sister and myself (age 5) in 1914 in front of the block house and covered wagon that stood on the square in Mansfield.

"We moved to Michigan and went back to visit in 1930 and the wagon had been put inside the building because of vandalism. Ten years ago when we were in Mansfield the building was gone. I often wondered what became of it. It was supposed to be the first house built in Mansfield and when I told my three year old brother about it, he said, "Is that where Adam and Eve lived?"
