Just below her last answer the complainant must sign her name, after which the Justice should write: "No further questions were asked. The foregoing questions and answers were reduced to writing by me, and, being read to the complainant, she subscribed the same in my presence, on the day of ..., 18..." And this statement the Justice must sign officially.

"The Justice before whom the examination is had, shall, within thirty days thereafter, file with the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas of the County a certified transcript of the proceedings, together with the recognizance, if any be taken, and all other papers therein."
