Mrs. Mary Wiler Cook, of No. 105 West Third street is the oldest resident of the city, having been born here Aug. 26, 1821.

It was thought that William Courtney was the oldest citizen of Mansfield when it was learned that he had been a resident here since 1822.

Mrs. Cook, who was formerly Mary Wiler, was born where the Wiler block now stands on N. Main street. Mr. Courtney is the oldest male inhabitant of the city in point of length of residence in Mansfield and Mrs. Cook is the oldest resident.
