


The Speaker for our 2016 Genealogy Workshop: Pam Vestal

Sessions 1 & 2: Finding Your Eastern European Ancestors. If I Can Do It, So Can You In spite of the many wars, boundary changes and political and natural catastrophes, an astonishing number of records exist for our Eastern European ancestors, both here and abroad. You don't have to be an expert on Eastern Europe to find and understand them. We'll talk about strategies for finding our immigrant ancestors' places of origin, uncovering their original names, identifying the location of records, requesting those records, extracting and understanding the information they contain, and dealing with foreign languages. Finally, you'll have a chance to work with actual documents to see how truly achievable this research can be.

Session 3: Voting Records: Genealogy's Best Kept Secret Voting records full of amazing genealogical information —have been stashed away, waiting to be discovered. Find out what gems they contain and where they might be hiding!

Session 4: Genealogical Pits I Have Fallen Into and How to Avoid Them

The best thing about making mistakes is the opportunity to learn from them. I've made my share of genealogical mistakes over the years, but I've learned that most of them have resulted from faulty assumptions. In this talk, we examine eight commonly-held but incorrect assumptions and consider some strategies and resources to help head off errors before they happen.
