First Generation

1. Mary Ann BRANT was born in January 1860 in Maryland. In the 1860 Census she is shown in Cumberland MD aged 5 months, daughter of Levi Brant, Coal Merchant, and Mary, aged 25. Also shown is Mary E Brant, aged 15. In the 1870 US Federal Census, she is shown as 10 year old 'Mollie', father Levi Brant, 48, Coal dealer; Mother Mary Brant, 44, and brother George, aged 4. Also one domestic and a cartman. Mary married John Lloyd THOMAS on 15 April 1880 in Mamaroneck NY. They appeared in the census on 8 June 1880 in Columbus, OH. John Lloyd Thomas appeared in the 1900 Census as Hotel Manager of the Manhattan Mills Hotel, Bleecker Street. He was age 43, said to have immigrated in 1867, naturalised. With him were Mary B, age 40 (b. Md, father born Md, Mother born W.Va); Mary L[ouise], born June 1881, Wash. D.C.; Lloyd b, b. Md, Aug 1882; Frances E [velyn?], born June 1888, New York; Arthur W, b. Oct 1889, New York; Gwyneth, age 2, born 1887 [this is a mistake? should be 1897?], New York; and pages and pages of men who were resident in this hotel for single working men. [See Wikipedia, New Mills Hotel]. They lived in the New Mills Hotel, New York City in 1920 census with their granddaughter Marion Putnam, aged 10. JLT was 62 and MBT was 60. The 1930 US Federal Census shows Mary B. Thomas, a widow aged 70, living in Westchester NY in a house owned by her worth \$18,000. She was in the household of James L. Kavanagh, age 39, born in Canada (father born Ireland, mother born England). He was a Credit Investor. His wife was Gwyneth T Kavanagh, age 32, who married at age 24. With them was their son Devereux J Kavanagh, aged 3. NEXT DOOR was the household of Arthur A. Thomas, renting at \$115 [per week? month?]. Aged 39, he married at age 26. He was born in NY. He was a Manager, [?] Coal Saver [the word 'Coal' is perhaps not right? The word Saver seems clear in the image]. His wife was Edith Thomas, aged 36. She and her parents were born in NY. With them were their son Lloyd G, 12, and daughter Jean M, 4. Mary died in 1943 in Mamaroneck NY?

Second Generation

- 2. Levi Winans BRANT was born in 1821 in Oldtown, Maryland. In the 1850 Census, L W Brant is shown as a Foreman on the railroad, born in Maryland, living in Hampshire, VA, in the home of John Waldron, Railroad Contractor. In the 1850 Census, Levi Brant lived in Hampshire, VA, in the household of John Waldron, RR Contractor, aged 45; his wife Naomia and their 7 children. Levi Brant was as Foreman, R.R. Also in the household were two other foremen on the railroad. Levi married Mary Tabitha ATHEY on 27 December 1851 in Cumberland Allegany Co MD. Levi Brant, age 38, appears as a coal merchant in the 1860 Census in Cumberland, MD, with house value of \$1400 and personal assets of \$400. He lives with Mary (age 25), Mary (5 months - who would marry John Lloyd Thomas]; and Mary E. [?] age 15. In 1870 Levi was a Coal Dealer in Cumberland, Maryland. In the 1870 Census they lived in Cumberland Maryland in a house worth \$6,000 and with personal property of \$5,000. In the household were Levi, 48, Coal Dealer; Mary [Athey], 44, keeper of the house (and had attended school); 'Mollie', age 10 [who would marry John Lloyd Thomas]; George, age 4; Sarah Rice, Domestic; and William Foster, 25, Cartman. Levi married Mary PITZER after March 1876. In 1880 Levi Brant, age 58, appears as a coal dealer in the Census in Cumberland MD. He lives with Mary (age 40, wife, keeping house); Sarah F, age 11 [whose father is said to have been born in Ohio]; and Annabella age 8, whose father is also said to have been born in Ohio. [This appears a bit strange. I think it is explained by the death in 1876 of Mary Tabitha Athey Brant. Levi must have re-married.]. Levi died of Pleurisy on 27 July 1886 in Cumberland Allegany Co MD.
- 3. Mary Tabitha ATHEY was born in 1826 (calculated) in W. Virginia. She died on 13 March 1876 in Cumberland, Maryland.
