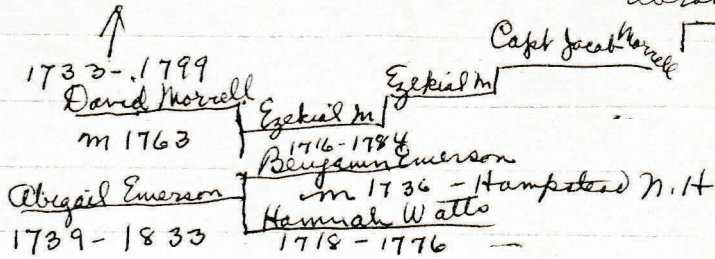

## Morrells in Delaware Valley

All seem to be descendants of Thomas Morrell<sup>I</sup> of Newtown, R. Id. Married to Hannah<sup>I</sup> in England and died in Newtown R. Id 1704

Thomas<sup>I</sup> named 2 sons as executors of his estate, Thomas<sup>II</sup> and Samuel, on a deed alluding to a will which was never found.

① Thomas<sup>II</sup>, son of Thomas<sup>I</sup> and Hannah<sup>I</sup> born in England 1662, married Hannah<sup>II</sup> in Newtown, R. Id in 6-18-1686. Date established by his parents, Thos<sup>I</sup> and Hannah<sup>I</sup> in "a gift of ten acres of land with provision for reversion in case of no issue. Several children and many records are collected but only 2 sons can be positively identified of this family. No church records of this period exist.

- ② Samuel Morrell son of Thos<sup>I</sup> + Hannah<sup>I</sup> born 1664 (approx) in England m. Susannah. Several children, the oldest
1. Samuel<sup>II</sup> m 6-12-1728 Phoebe Bailey, moved to Nj + died there leaving a widow and 6 children. Will on file in Trenton.
  2. Wm m. Mary Fennerien, Burlington, Nj. He died 10-28-1730 His posterity is large.
  3. Sarah m. John Smith and remained in Newtown L. Id.
  4. Hannah m. John Bailey of L. Id.
- ③ Wm Morrell, son of Thos' and Hannah' m Elizabeth and is frequently of record - many deeds and other recorded papers executed by him as late as 1727, then none. Elizabeth, his wife, between 1716 + 1723 joined in all deeds. Before and after, he signed alone. No descendants known positively.

④ Sarah, dau of Thos + Hannah, nothing known except she was an adult in Newtown L. Id in 1685. "Sarah" frequently in Morrell records - impossible to specify proper place of each.

⑤ Abigail - only record, baptized Oct 3, 1711 (an adult)

⑦ Jonathon, son of Thos + Hannah b. <sup>L. Id.</sup> Newtown, 1670 d 1726

↙ m Judith - 2 children, Jonathon, baptized Aug. 15 - 1697
