39th (Dorsetshire) Regiment of Foot Soldiers' documents Formed in 1702, designated as 39th Regiment in 1751 and became the East Middlesex Regiment in 1782 Disbanded and drafted into the 104th Regiment in 1795. In 1807 it was

reformed as the 39th (Dorsetshire) Regiment. The first battalion went from the south of France to Canada and served in the expedition to Plattsburg in 1814. Afterwards returning to Europe, it landed at Ostend a month after the battle of Waterloo had been fought. After 1855 the regiment was for some years in Canada and Bermuda, returning home from the latter station in 1864.

Some 500 British soldiers, in annoyance at hearing the bugle call to retreat, threw down their arms and deserted to the American side
