

Johannes<sup>1</sup> Schlabbach was born Abt. 1695. He lived in Cleeburg, and died in Trenton, Middlesex, New Jersey. He married Maria Elizabeth Abt. 1719 in Zweibroucken, Alsace.

#### Notes for Johannes Schlabbach:

Johannes Schlabbach arrived with his family in 1733 on the Pink Mary from Rotterdam. They traveled there from Alsace, Lorraine in France. They were Palatinates who left because of religious persecusion. They settled in Trenton, New Jersey. Other spellings: Schlappach, Schlapbach. They originated in Switzerland and Alsace.

Michael Hammer of Huntingdon County New Jersey was in the four man party which was naturalized April 7, 1761 with David Slayback-2nd. generation.

Eventually third generation, Solomon Slayback migrated with his brothers Abel and William to Fayette County, Kentucky.


