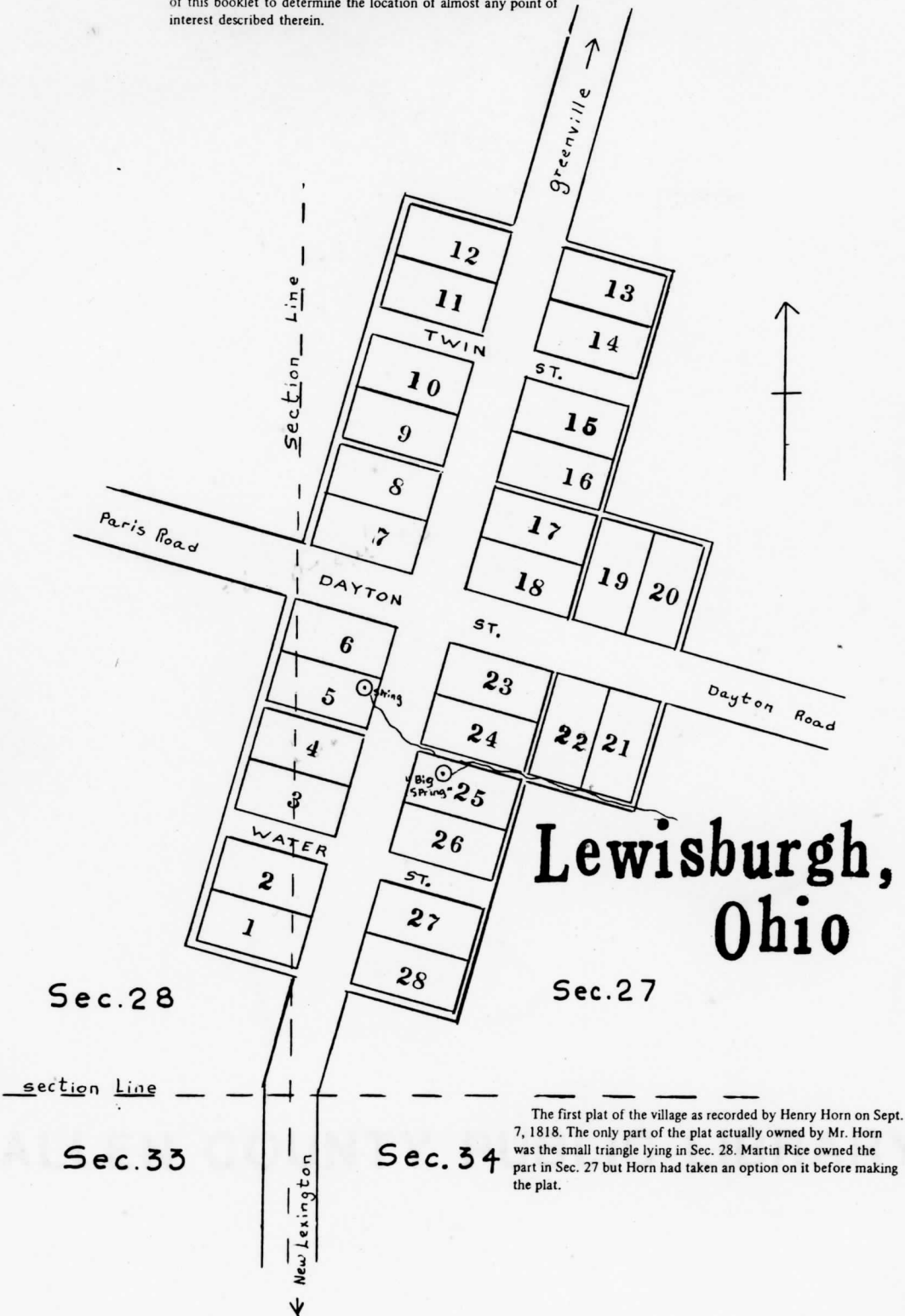


MAP SECTION

The maps on the following pages were made up freehand by the compiler of this history. They were taken from historical and official records and are for historical use only. They are of no value whatever for official reference. No attempt has been made to correct any obvious errors such as mis-spelled words, incorrect courses of streams, etc. The maps are intended to aid the reader of this booklet to determine the location of almost any point of interest described therein.



The first plat of the village as recorded by Henry Horn on Sept. 7, 1818. The only part of the plat actually owned by Mr. Horn was the small triangle lying in Sec. 28. Martin Rice owned the part in Sec. 27 but Horn had taken an option on it before making the plat.
