

**Descendants of
Robert Neumann (1840-1893)
and
Anna Guelich (1842-1914)**

Robert Neumann¹ was born on 18 Jun 1840 in Germany,² died on 29 Oct 1893 in Spicewood, Burnet County, Texas² at age 53, and was buried in Rockvale Cemetery, Spicewood, Burnet County, Texas.³

Robert and Anna Neumann arrived in America on 29 Sep 1883, with their three children--Oscar, Annie, and Paul--at Galveston Texas. They came from Fromsdorf, Germany, on the ship "Weser" from the port of Bremen, Germany. The ship left Bremen on 6 Sep 1883.

In Germany, Robert Neumann had been a cobbler.

They went to Austin, Texas, and were met by Henry Naumann. They settled on the Turner Farm on the Colorado River near Spicewood, Texas, for about 4 years. It is likely that son Joseph was born there. Sometime later they moved to Spicewood, Texas, where they rented land for a while.

Adolph Wall remembered his mother Annie talking about living in a log house on what later became the Jack and Lera Thompson place and then owned by Halton Ray Naumann. They raised wild hogs in pens there in agreement with the Drs. Yett that ranched north of there. They later farmed the Rice place which they eventually bought, where Max Wall farmed, and later his daughter Maxine and Bill Alman owned.

Robert declared his intentions to become a naturalized citizen on 25 Jul 1887 in Travis County, Texas. His son Oscar's petition for citizenship states that Robert died without having been admitted a citizen.

They bought the Lewis Moore place in Spicewood, Texas, in 1890. Robert established two notes to purchase the farm. Both were paid by 1891. Later Chris Fritz and Annie Wall lived there and then Adolph and Elizabeth Wall.

He died after being kicked by a horse on his ranch.

The Neumanns were Catholic, but the nearest church was in Austin. They were not known to attend any church in the Spicewood area.

Robert married **Anna Guielich**.^{4,5} Anna was born on 2 Jun 1842 in Germany,⁶ died on 25 Dec 1914 in Spicewood, Burnet County, Texas⁶ at age 72, and was buried in Rockvale Cemetery, Spicewood, Burnet County, Texas.^{6,7} They had five children: **Oscar Robert August, Annie, Paul Robert, Joseph, and Emma**.

The Neumann family arrived in America on 29 Sep 1883, at Galveston Texas. They came from Fromsdorf, Germany, on the ship "Weser" from the port of Bremen, Germany. The ship left Bremen on 6 Sep 1883.

Anna was listed as head of household on the 1900 census. She was widowed. She had borne 7 children with 5 still living. She and her parents were born in Germany. Her 3 youngest children were living with her and her daughter Annie and Fritz Wall were living next to her. She was a farmer and owned her farm free of any mortgage. It was reported the same way in 1910. On the 1910 census, she was reported to have borne 5 children with 5 still living. The census entry showed that she spoke German, not English. Her youngest son Joseph was living with her and was a laborer on the home farm.

Transcription of tombstone on www.findagrave.com shows birth as 2 Dec 1842.

Her maiden name was recorded as Guielich on son Oscar's death record in California. A paper from Oscar's family had it handwritten as Goulich. Joseph Newman showed it as Guhlich on her death certificate. It was recorded as Goolidge on Joseph's death certificate by nephew Adolph Wall.

Oscar Robert August Neumann^{8,9,10} was born on 13 Feb 1872 in Fromsdorf, , Germany,¹¹ died on 25 Mar 1962 in Banning, Riverside County, California¹¹ at age 90, and was buried in Visalia Public Cemetery, Visalia, Tulare County, California.¹²

The Neumann family arrived in America on 29 Sep 1883, at Galveston Texas. They came from Fromsdorf, Germany, on the ship "Weser" from the port of Bremen, Germany. The ship left Bremen on 6 Sep 1883.

Oscar was granted his United States citizenship on 4 Apr 1898 in Burnet County, Texas.

Oscar went to California in 1906 where he remained for the rest of his life. He was a farmer and had a walnut grove. He returned to Texas for a visit in the late 1930's. There were no children from his marriage to Alwina; however his wife had a son, Gerhard Barsch from her first marriage.

At the time of the 1910 census, Oscar was farming in Visalia, Tulare County, California. He gave the immigration year of 1883 and reported that he was a naturalized citizen. He had been married for 1 year. His stepson, Gerhard V. Barsch, 7 years old, born in Pennsylvania was listed with him. Gerhard's father seems to have been born in Germany. The birthplace report was turned around a bit between the 1910 and 1920 census reports.

(Gerhard's California Death Index record showed his birthplace as Germany. Name: Gerhard V Barsch Social Security #: 572019751 Sex: MALE Birth Date: 12 Jan 1903 Birthplace: Germany Death Date: 2 Jul 1973 Death Place: Orange)

On the 1920 census, Oscar reported that he was paying a mortgage to own his home in Visalia, Tulare County, California. He was farming a general farm. His birthplace was shown as Missouri, but that was the census taker's error. The person above him was born in Missouri. Oscar was still in Visalia at the time of the 1930 census. He owned his home on a farm. He gave his birthplace as Frehmsdorf, Germany. He gave his immigration year as 1882. He was a general farmer. (Other records show Fromsdorf and the year 1883.)

He was living in Palm Springs, Riverside County, California, in 1960. He had been living in Riverside County, California, two years at the time of his death.

Oscar married **Alwina Augusta**^{8,9,10} in California. Alwina was born on 1 Aug 1874 in Pennsylvania¹³ and died on 19 Nov 1958 in Tulare County, California¹³ at age 84.

Her name is pronounced Alvina. The spelling shown is what was on her California Death Index record. Presumably her husband Oscar or son Gerhard Barsch provided the information. In the German language "w" is pronounced "v".

Alwina was born in Pennsylvania. Her parents were born in Germany. Her first husband, Barsch, was born in Germany. She married him at age 25. She only had one child, Gerhart. Her second husband, Oscar Neumann, helped raise him.

Annie Neumann^{14,15,16,17,18,19} was born on 20 Jul 1876 in Fromsdorf, , Germany,²⁰ died on 27 Feb 1960 in Spicewood, Burnet County, Texas^{20,21} at age 83, and was buried on 29 Feb 1960 in Rockvale Cemetery, Spicewood, Burnet County, Texas.^{20,22}

The Neumann family arrived in America on 29 Sep 1883, at Galveston Texas. They came from Fromsdorf, Germany, on the ship "Weser" from the port of Bremen, Germany. The ship left Bremen on 6 Sep 1883.

Annie was inconsistent in giving her age. Her grandson Wayne Wall speculated that she may have wanted to conceal the fact that she was a little older than her husband. She gave her birth date as Jun 1877 and age as 22 on the 1900 census, 30 on the 1910 census, 43 on the 1920 census, and 53 on the 1930 census.

Her birthplace was listed incorrectly as Texas on the 1900 census, but correctly as Germany on all the other census years. Her parents were born in Germany. Her native language was German but she spoke English.

By the time of the 1900 census, she had borne 1 child, still living. By the time of the 1910 census, she had borne 5 children, with all still living. On the 1920 census, she reported that she had immigrated to America in 1880 and was naturalized as a citizen. On the 1930 census, she gave the immigration year as 1883. (Ship passenger lists show that 1883 was correct.) At the time of the 1940 census, Annie was widowed and shown as head of household with sons, Edward, Oscar and Adolph still at home and farming the home place.

Annie was Catholic, but was known to attend the Spicewood Baptist Church. Rev. Frank Tulloch of Marble Falls officiated at her graveside services.

Annie married **Chris Fritz Wall**,^{23,24,25,26,27,28} son of **Mike Wall**^{27,30,31,32,33,34} and **Wilhelmina D. Garlipp**,^{27,30,31,33,35} on 27 Nov 1898 in Corwin (now Spicewood), Burnet County, Texas.²⁹ C.F. was born on 13 Sep 1876 in Nelsonville, Austin County, Texas,^{36,37} died on 19 May 1937 in Smithville, Bastrop County, Texas^{37,38,39} at age 60, and was buried on 20 May 1937 in Rockvale Cemetery, Spicewood, Burnet County, Texas.⁴⁰ He was usually called C.F. They had six children: **Robert, Max, Minnie, Edward, Oscar, and Adolph Edwin**.

The marriage between Annie and Chris Fritz Wall was performed by D. A. McInnish at her parents' home in what is now known as Spicewood. It was served by the Corwin post office at that time and was reported as Corwin in the newspaper.

Chris Fritz Wall was a farmer, rancher, County Road Commissioner for 14 years and raised a lot of bees. He was a Spicewood School trustee.

Newspaper clipping (no date): C.F. was born in Austin County in 1876. When he was 5, the family moved to Bastrop. At 6, they moved to the Turner Farm in Travis County until 08/1887 when they moved to Bastrop, living there until 1891. In 1891 they bought the farm in Spicewood. In 1908 he was a trustee of the Double Horn School. In 1920 C.F. was elected County Commissioner, Precinct 4 and was still in office in 1934.

At the time of the 1900 census, Fritz rented his farm in Burnet County, Texas. He had been married 1 year. By the time of the 1910 census, Fritz owned his farm in Burnet County, Texas, free of any mortgage. It was listed as a general farm. He registered for the WWI draft using and signing the name Cris Fritz Wall. He was a self employed stock farmer in Spicewood, Burnet County, Texas. His wife, Annie, was his nearest relative. His situation remained the same for the 1920 and 1930 census. Brother-in-law, Joe Neumann age 34, was listed with the family in 1920. He was a laborer on a general farm.

Fritz gave his father's birthplace as Germany in 1900 and 1910, but as Belgium in 1920 and 1930. He indicated that his father spoke Flemish on the 1920 census.

C.F. Wall, 63, well-known farmer of Spicewood, in Smithville to attend the funeral of his uncle, August Bunte Sr, toppled from a chair and died here Wednesday at 6 a.m. of a heart attack.

Mr. Wall was sitting on the back porch of the Bunte home when he was stricken. (An article in the Smithville Times gave the time as 6:30 a.m. and the place as the home of his brother in law, Henry Bunte.)

He had come to Smithville after receiving notice of the death of Mr. Bunte, who succumbed early Tuesday to injuries received in an automobile accident near Austin as Bunte was returning home from a visit to the Wall family.

Funeral services were pending Wednesday for the Spicewood man.

Surviving him are his widow; one daughter, Mrs. Walter Fasel of Johnson City; and five sons, Robert, Max, Ed, Oscar and Adolphus Wall of Spicewood.

C.F. WALL DIES OF HEART ATTACK

This entire county was shocked yesterday morning when word was received that Mr. C.F. Wall had died at 6 a.m. from a heart attack. Mr. Wall was in Smithville at the time of his passing. He and his wife were called to that place to attend the funeral of Mr. August Bunte a relative who was killed by injuries received in a car wreck.

Mr. Wall's body was brought overland yesterday and interment is being held this afternoon in the Rockvale cemetery between Marble Falls and Spicewood.

Mr. Wall is known to practically all of Burnet County. He served this precinct for many years as commissioner and was always doing some act of worthiness for his neighbors and friends. Mr. Wall has numbers of friends and a host of relatives who are sorry to hear of his passing and the large concourse of friends journeying to the cemetery this afternoon attest to the high esteem in which this good man was held.

Mr. Wall was 60 years of age at the time of his passing having been born Sept 13, 1876.

Besides his wife, Mr. Wall leaves five sons and one daughter to mourn his passing. The sons are Ed, Oscar, Robert, Max and Adolph Wall, all of the Spicewood community. The daughter is Mrs. Walter Fasel. Three brothers August, Will and T.B. Wall, survive and also two sisters Mrs. Jack Thompson and Mrs. Henry Bunte. He is also survived by a large host of other relatives.

The Messenger joins the many friends in extending heartfelt sympathy to the bereaved.

C.F.'s birth date was given as 13 Sep 1877 and his mother's maiden name was misspelled as Galip on his death

certificate by H.C. Bunte, who was the informant.

He has conflicting birth information of 13 Sep 1877.⁴¹

Robert Wall^{42,43,44,45,46} was born on 13 Aug 1899 in Spicewood, Burnet County, Texas,⁴⁷ died on 9 Jan 1978 in Spicewood, Burnet County, Texas^{48,49} at age 78, and was buried on 10 Jan 1978 in Rockvale Cemetery, Spicewood, Burnet County, Texas.⁵⁰

When Robert registered for the WWI draft and at the time of the 1920 census, he was farming for his father C.F. Wall in Burnet County, Texas. The newspaper reported on 17 Nov 1918 that he was called up for his physical examination. He did not have to serve however.

At the time of the 1930 census, he was married with 2 children. He had married at age 21. He owned his home on a farm in Burnet County, Texas. He was farming a general farm.

In Jan 1946, Robert declared his intention to run for commissioner in precinct 4 of Burnet County after learning that Mr. Shifflett was not standing for reelection. He had planned to cease farming his land and devote his entire time to the office of commissioner.

Robert was primarily a stock farmer. He had served on the board of the A.S.C.S. in Burnet County. He was a lifelong resident of Spicewood, Burnet County, Texas. He was a member of the Spicewood Baptist Church.

Social Security had his last benefit as Burnet, Burnet County, Texas, and his last residence as Marble Falls, Burnet County, Texas. The mail was delivered out of Marble Falls at that time, but the actual residence was in Spicewood, Texas.

Krause**,^{51,59,60,61,62,63} on 26 Dec 1920 in Spicewood, Burnet County, Texas.^{54,55} Inez was born on 2 Sep 1895 in Corwin, Burnet County, Texas,⁶⁴ died on 3 Jan 1970 in Burnet, Burnet County, Texas^{49,64} at age 74, and was buried on 4 Jan 1970 in Rockvale Cemetery, Spicewood, Burnet County, Texas.^{64,65} They had two children: **Robert Elvin** and **Doris Fae**.

R. A. Mobley, ordained minister of the gospel, performed the marriage ceremony between Inez and Robert Wall at the August Naumann home.

Her birth date was listed as Sep 1896 age 4 on the 1900 census. She was a laborer on the home farm in Burnet County, Texas, at the time of the 1920 census. Her father Friedrich August Naumann was born in Germany. Her mother Isabella E. Krause was born in Texas. She reported both born in Germany on the 1930 census.

She was a lifetime resident of Spicewood, Texas.

Robert married **Sigrid Hinselmann**,^{66,67,68,69} daughter of **W. H. E. Hinselmann**, on 24 Oct 1953 in University Baptist Church, Austin, Travis County, Texas. Alan Sandberg was a technology nerd with a big heart.

Sandberg, 59, of Victoria, died Tuesday morning following a crash on his motorcycle on state Highway 185 at Matchette Road, near Crescent Valley.

"He was a warm man, a loving man. He'd do anything for anyone," said Sandberg's son Clint Sandberg. "He had a steady hand, a warm heart, a good shoulder and a good listening ear."

Clint said one of his father's greatest attributes was his ability to encourage others.

"He was always full of praise," said the younger Sandberg. "He found it easy to find words of encouragement and to tell someone he was proud of them."

Sandberg rarely drove the Yamaha to his job as a senior engineer in the technology department at DuPont, where he had worked for 35 years, said Trudie Sandberg, his wife of almost 20 years.

"He was a technology nerd. That's what he did. He was a chemical processing computer technician," said his wife.

Away from work, Sandberg, a grandfather of four, attended Fellowship Bible Church in Victoria with his wife.

"He was a strong Christian," she said. "He loved God. He loved life."

Sandberg, who liked to travel in the couple's spare time, also enjoyed working on their property near Austin.

"He liked to tinker there," his wife said.

The crash occurred about 7:25 a.m., when a 1994 Chevrolet Suburban pulled onto the highway and Sandberg could not avoid hitting it, said Department of Public Safety spokesman Trooper Gerald Bryant.

"There was 30 to 40 feet of skid marks from the motorcycle," said investigating Trooper Stephen Gray. "He went down and hit the left rear tire of the Suburban. It was at least a 65- to 70-mph hit."

Sandberg was wearing a helmet, said Gray.

Winston Byrd, of Victoria, the driver of the Suburban, was taking two children to school, said the trooper.

Sandberg was taken by Victoria Fire Department ambulance to Citizens Medical Center.

"I got a call from the hospital that he had been rushed to surgery with liver damage," Gray said.

He was pronounced dead at the hospital at 12:35 p.m., said Gray, who is continuing to investigate the crash.

Trudie Sandberg said her husband was a giving man.

"He would do anything for anyone," she said. "He had a servant's heart."

On the 1920 census, Paul indicated that he was paying a mortgage to own his home in Burnet County, Texas. He gave his immigration year as 1883 and the code of PA was entered in response to the naturalization question. He was farming a general farm. He was not listed with his wife Vivian on the 1930 census and I could not find him listed elsewhere.

From 1932 through 1936, his sister Emma's family the Prehns rented his farm in Spicewood, Texas.

Paul did many different things during his life time, but his major occupation was a farmer. He is remembered for building a fine home with a roof garden, indoor cistern with a pump and a double fireplace for a living room and bed room. He liked to work with iron, steel and other metals. He was the blacksmith for the Spicewood Community, and was known for his ability to make things of metal. There were no children.

Will left home at an early age and worked for a Dr. Keidel in Fredericksburg, Texas. About 1910, Will attended Barber School in San Antonio, Texas. He owned a barber shop and barbered in Spicewood for a short while. Archie Dean Krause bought the shop from him for \$25. He stayed in practice by cutting the hair of his 5 sons.

His mother in law Anna Neumann gave or helped him acquire about 160 acres north of the county road (now CR 404) from the home place in Spicewood, Texas.

When Will registered for the WWI draft 6 May 1917, he was farming in Spicewood, Burnet County, Texas. He had a wife and 3 children and requested an exemption based on his occupation and relatives. At the time of the 1920 census, Will owned his home in Burnet County, Texas, free of any mortgage. He was a farmer on a general farm. He served on the Board of Trustees for the Spicewood School for several years.

On 11 Sep 1924 the Marble Falls Messenger carried a report that Will had sold part of his Spicewood property and bought a farm in Jourdanton. On 24 Nov 1925, the paper reported that the family had moved. Son Weldon recalled that it was about 400 acres and it was mortgaged. They had a small dairy operation there.

At the time of the 1930 census, the family was living in Atascosa County, Texas, where Will was also shown as a farmer on a general farm. They lived on a farm and he owned his home. By 1932 he had lost his farm. They moved down the road about a mile and rented for a while. After harvesting the cotton in Jourdanton in the fall of 1932, they went back to Spicewood where they rented Paul Neumann's farm through 1936. The newspaper reported the Will Prehn family back in Burnet County, Texas, in Oct 1932.

In 1936 Will agreed to rent a 500 acre farm in Cypress Mill, Blanco County, Texas, from Fritz Wenmohs. Will became extremely ill from a carbuncle on his neck in Jun 1936 and in spite of surgeries and treatment in Breckenridge Hospital in Austin, Texas, and Scott & White Hospital in Temple, Texas, he failed to regain his health. His daughter Etheline took care of the family during his hospitalization and his wife Emma returned home long enough to help them move to Cypress Mill around Christmas. The doctors released Will to go home when there was no more that they could do for him and he died soon after returning to his home.
