In August 1831, Brushy Creek Baptist Church minutes recorded:

*"There was a request for an arm of this Church to be formed at Mountain Creek Meeting House, it was granted."*

September 3, 1831: *"Several members of this Church met at Mountain Creek Meeting House and form an arm to this Church and then open'd a door for membership, when Anderson Roberts, James Roberts, Adeline Roberts, Polly Roberts and Milly Roberts came forward and related Christian experience one at a time and were received. The members of this church that went off to form the arm at Mountain Creek were as follows: Hiram Roberts, Tyre Roberts, John Roberts, Sherrod Roberts, Sarah Roberts, Elizabeth Roberts and Dorha Roberts, seven in number."*

These three member rolls from the 1830s to 1840s reflect a time when the church grew in the community between Paris Mountain and Chick Springs.
