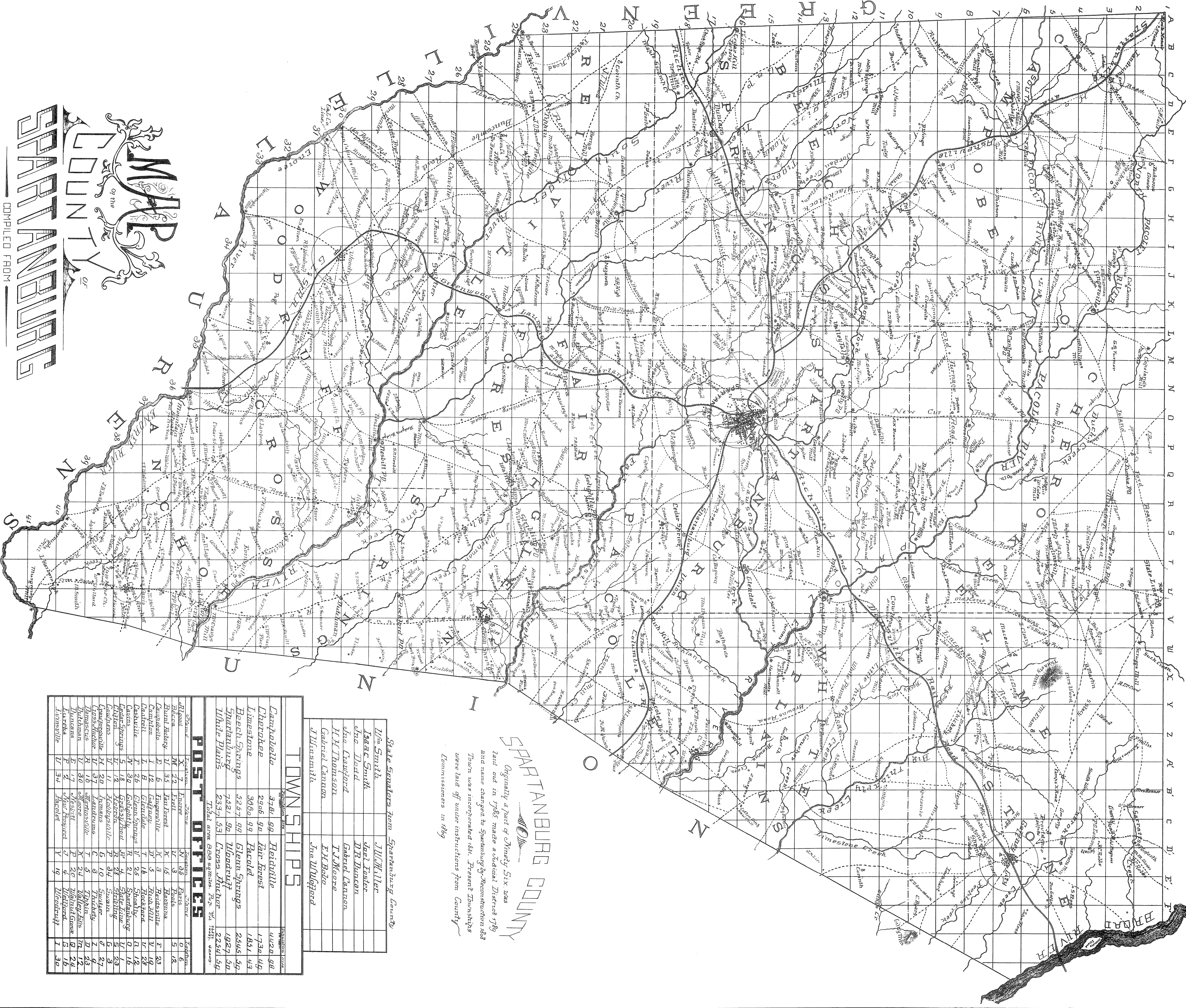


NORTH CAROLINA
