Neighbor's Affidavit.

NOTE.-This should be fworn to before a CLERK of the COURT or his DEPUTY, or any NOTARY PURLIC or JUBTICE of the PEACE, provided if executed before a Notary or Justice, the certificate of the court must be attached unless the Notary or Justice has a certificate already on file in the Pension Office. In such case the Notary or Justice must state that such certificate is on file. Neglect to comply wiih this requirement will cause trouble and delay.

In this connection, if the witnesses have been his employers, or have

may have been; what his actual earnings were, and whether or not the wages paid him were less in amount, and how much
less on account of his inability to labor, than were paid to others physically sound and doing the same
