TENNESSEE STATE SOCIETY ON FACEBOOK

Following the recommendation made at Summer Board, a Facebook site has been created. Though this seemed like a simple process, it was not simple to do it in a way that was not connected to a personal Facebook account. So our Facebook ACCOUNT is under the name “TnSociety Colonial Dames Seventeenth-Century.” This is the initial site that people will see, but that is an information page, not one for posting. For the page where you can post, you have to be a member of the group Tennessee Society Colonial Dames XVII Century, so you will need to initiate a friend request or respond to a friend request from the group. (1) You need to have a Facebook account (if you don’t have one, click on the link below and a page will come up where you can add your e-mail and password to create a FB account). (2) On your Facebook page, in the search box at top left type **Tennessee Society Colonial Dames XVII Century** (or just click the link below). (3) Click the “Join” button at the top of the page. The administrator will have to approve your request (you will need to be on the membership list of the state society or otherwise listed in the State Directory). You will receive an e-mail when you are approved. Then you should see our group in your list of groups on your Facebook page and you can then post messages and pictures on the group page and see and respond to what others have posted. Please keep posts relative to Society business or items of interest to genealogists. The address for the group is:
