LOCKNEY, June 22 - Funeral services for Mrs. Mary Abigalle Galliher (sic Mary Abbiegale Golleher, 72, were held at 2 p.m. today in the West side Church of Christ here. Elder Omer Kirk of Floydada officiated.

Burial was in Carrs Chapel Cemetery under direction of Carter Funeral Home.

Mrs. Galliher (sic - Mrs. Golleher) of Earth died at a Wichita Falls hospital Sunday.

She was born Mary Abigaile Shelton (sic Mary Abbiegale Shelton) on Sept. 4, 1887 in Giles County, Tenn. She married Robert Galliher (sic Robert Golleher on Aug 10, 1902 at Rocket, Texas. The family moved to Carrs Chapel, 15 miles south of here in 1914. They lived on a farm there for 19 years. Mrs. Galliher (sic Mrs. Golleher) lived briefly in the Irick community, then moved to Earth where she had lived until last year.

Survivors include her husband three sons, Calvin of Roundtop, George of Wichita Falls, and R.L. of Mission; two daughters, Mrs. Eva Mae Tarpley of Weatherford and Mrs. Thelma Ellis of Monette, Mo; a brother, George Shelton of Olney; two half-brothers, Jack Hollingsworth of Roaring Springs and Jera Hollingsworth (sic Jord Hollingsworth) of Silverton; two half-sisters, Mrs. Ida Belle Womac (sic Ida Belle Womack) of Floydada and Mrs. Irene May of Plainview; 13 grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren.
