

## **Kerrville Area**

**Brown** – Est'd 1872 for the family of Joshua Brown, the County's first settler. On TX 27 east of Kerrville past VA Medical Center, turn left on Spur 100. Next to VA National Cemetery. 30°00.808N & 99°06.610W Historical Marker

**Garden of Memories** – From Kerrville .9 miles north of I-10 on TX16. Over 8000 graves. 30°04.770N & 99°05.928W

**Garden of Memories North** – Est'd ~1968. Black community cemetery located at the end of Webster St next to Carver Park. Over 150 graves. 30°03.535N & 99°08.491W

**Gate of Heaven** – Est'd 1950. On grounds of Kerrville State Hospital at Thompson Dr and Shepard Rees Rd. Security guard escort required. 30°02.751N & 99°09.779W

**Glen Rest** – Est'd 1882. East off TX27 near Schreiner University. 30°01.757N & 99°08.061W

**Guadalupe** – Est'd 1917. Hispanic cemetery located on Town Creek Rd, just past the intersection of Bluebonnet Dr and Town Creek Rd. Over 275 marked graves with the most notable being that of Father Kemper, who started the town's Notre Dame Catholic Church. 30°03710N & 99°08746W

**Harris Family** – Est'd 1886. Located 100 yd. northwest of Delaney Hall, on the Schreiner University campus. 7 graves. 30°01.744N & 99°07.914W

**Holliman** – Est'd 1898. From Kerrville, go south on TX 16 to left TX 173. The cemetery is on the right just before the intersection with Loop 534. 15 graves. 30°00.729N & 99°07.445W

**Mountain View** – Mountain View Cemetery was Kerrville's first city cemetery, started in 1863. Over 600 graves. Located on the southwest corner of Sidney Baker St & Holdsworth Dr near Antler Stadium. 30°03.335N & 99°08.014W

**Starkey** – Est'd 1863. 10 graves. 1480 Junction Hwy (TX27) next to WalMart. 30°03.669N & 99°10.067W Designated a Texas Historic Cemetery

**Tivy Mountain** – A city-owned, un-kept cemetery with 140 known graves. NW corner of FM 1341 & Loop 534. 30°03.151N & 99°06.793W

**Tivy Family** – Est'd 1888. 3 graves. South from intersection of Loop 534 & FM 1341 about 300 yards. Locked gate entrance 30 yards south of Capt Tivy historical marker. Cemetery 500 yards up hill. 30°03.132N & 99°07.169W Private Property.

**VA National** – Est'd 1923. Over 500 graves. On TX 27 east of Kerrville past VA Medical Center, turn left on Spur 100. Next to Brown Cemetery. 30°00.835N & 99°06.584W

## **Center Point & Camp Verde Areas**

**Altenheim** – Located at Hermann Sons, west of Comfort on TX27. Most of the markers have the name of the Lodge to which the person belonged. 29°56.253N & 98°55.762W

**Bishop Surber** – Est'd ~1880. 7 readable stones. Near Kendall County line. Private property

**Bolin Family** – One burial. From Center Point north on Stoneleigh Rd 1 1/2 mi. Just prior to intersection with McDonald Loop, the cemetery is on the left behind a wrought-iron fence. 29°59.385N & 99°01.180W Private Property

**Bridges** – Est'd 1938. Two graves. Located just off Elm Pass Rd, 3 miles south of Center Point

**Camp Verde Community** – Est'd 1892. Over 100 graves. South from Kerrville on TX 16 to TX 173, turn left and continue on TX 173 11.2 miles to Camp Verde. Turn right on Camp Verde Rd which runs along the north bank of Verde Creek. Cemetery is one-half-mile on the left. 29°53.540N & 99°06.710W

**Camp Verde Fort** – Est'd before 1874. Believed to have only two graves. South from Kerrville on TX 16 to TX 173, turn left and continue on TX 173 11.2 miles to Camp Verde. Turn right on Camp Verde Road which runs along the north bank of Verde Creek. A half-mile down this road you will see the cemetery on the left 29°53.425N & 99°07.221W Private Property.

**Center Point** – Est'd 1859. Historically significant for the more than 30 Texas Rangers buried there. More than 1300 graves. East from Kerrville on TX 27 to Center Point (about 10 miles). Turn right on FM 480/San Antonio St toward Camp Verde. The Cemetery entrance is on the right. 29°56.099N & 99°02.270W Historical Marker

**Cravey Family** – Located on Warren Ingenhuett Ranch, 7 miles south of Center Point. Three marked graves. Private property.

**Cypress Creek Community** – Est'd 1860. From Kerrville, N on TX 16, right on Loop 534. Left on FM 1341 10 miles, Right on Stoneleigh/Lazy Valley. Cross bridge. Drive ¾ mile. Cemetery is on right in a grove of trees. 30°01.036N & 98°59.208W Historical Marker. Private Property

**Denton** – Est'd 1874. 5-grave plot. On Cherry Creek off Lane Valley Rd. Private property.

**Haebecker Family** – From Kerrville, south on TX 16 to left on FM 2771. Located ¾ mile on right. 6 graves. 29°57.955N & 99°10.692W

**Heise Family** – Est'd 1873. 4 graves. 3 miles south of Center Point. Private Property

**Lane Valley** – Two close-by Black family cemeteries est'd 1904 & 1914. 7 gravestones plus several unmarked graves. Lane Valley Rd. Private property

**Moore Family** – Est'd 1861. 2 graves. On the old George Sutherland Ranch, between Old Center Point Road and Texas 27. Private property

**Real Family** – Est'd 1861. ~50 graves. South from Kerrville on TX 173. Right on FM 2771 (Lower Turtle Creek Rd.) for 3.4 miles. Cemetery is on left. 29°57.653N & 99°08.810W Private Property

**San Jose** – Over 200 graves. Northwest of Comfort on Cypress Creek Road (FM 1341) 29°58.171N & 8°55.893W

**Schuts** – Est'd 1892. 2 graves. North from Camp Verde on TX 173 toward Kerrville ½ mile. Left into old Alliger Ranch. Plot is immediately on left behind barbed wire fence. 29°53.922N & 99°06.460W Private Property

**Stieler** – 1 grave, overgrown, near Roggenbucke Homestead in Comfort/Cypress Creek area

**Turtle Creek** – Est'd 1873. From Kerrville south on TX 16 for 8 miles. Right on FM 1273. One mile, on right surrounded by chain link fence. 29°58.499N & 99°13.221W Historical marker

**Verde Valley** – Est'd 1865. 11 graves. Located on the Verde Valley Ranch, between Center Point and Camp Verde.

**Walters Family** – 2 grave plot. TX 173 south to Camp Verde. Left at store on Camp Verde Rd. Cemetery with rock pillars pass store on left. 29°53.664N & 99°06.221W Private Property.

**Wharton Family** – Est'd 1870. ~30 graves. From Kerrville, south on TX 173 for 4.9 miles. Left on Wharton Rd 1.2 miles. Cemetery on right behind fence. 29°58.330N & 99°05.693W Historical marker

### **Hunt, Ingram, Mt. Home, Divide Areas**

**Baldwin Family** – Est'd 1892. ~60 graves. West from Ingram on TX 39 for 3.6 miles. Left .4 miles on Kelley Creek Rd to right on Baldwin Rd. 30°03.967N & 99°17.746W

**Bonnie Hills** – Located on FM 187 going toward Leahey from TX 39, aka Wilson Family. Private Property.

**Colbath Family** – Est'd 1927. West from Kerrville on TX 27. Left on Arcadia Loop. Right on Bear Creek Rd. 2.3 miles to cemetery entrance on right. 30°02.979N & 99°13.367W Private Property

**Conn Family** – Est'd 1900. Located off FM 1340, on Bear Creek Boy Scout Ranch. 10 gravestones. 30°02.505N & 99°08.632W Private Property.

**Crider Family** – newest family cemetery in Kerr County. One grave. Located across from Crider's Dance & Rodeo on TX 39 west of Hunt.

**Dry Branch** – TX27 west from Ingram 6 miles. On approach side of Dry Branch Creek park on left side and climb a small steep hill. Cemetery on top surrounded by chain link fence. 14 graves. 30°08.170N & 99°18.92W

**Henderson Family** – Est'd 1870. ~30 graves. 2 miles west of Ingram on TX 27, right 2.3 miles on Henderson Branch Rd 30°07.261N & 99°14.460W Historical Marker. Private Property

**Hunt Japonica** – Oldest cemetery in Kerr County begun 8 years before county formed in 1856. 1 mile NW of Hunt on FM 1340 30°04.679N & 99°20.790W Historical marker

**Nichols** – Est'd 1859. More than 800 graves. 30°04.359N & 99°12.939W Historical Markers

**Sunset** – Est'd 1872. 9 miles west of Ingram on TX 27, left on Sunset Cemetery Rd .3 miles 30°09.368N & 99°21.057W Historical Marker
