Before me, Lee Wallace, County Judge, Kerr County, Texas, on this day personally appeared ~~William~~ *Henry* ~~Schmidt~~, known to me to be a creditable person, who being by me duly sworn upon his oath deposes and says that he is 81 years of age; that he resides at Kerrville, Texas, and that he knew Miles A. Lowrance, who served in the Confederacy and that the said Miles A. Lowrance enlisted at Kerrville, Texas, at the beginning of the war in 1861; and from his standing in the community it was general knowledge that the said Miles A. Lowrance was a Confederate Veteran and rendered good and valuable services to the Confederacy and that from what he has heard of the man that he never deserted. That affiant was well and intimately acquainted with the said Miles A. Lowrance during his life time; that he knows his widow Mrs. Margaret A. Lowrance and that the said Margaret A. Lowrance lived together as husband and wife until the death of the said Miles A. Lowrance. That the said Margaret A. Lowrance has lived in the State of Texas practically all of her life. That the said Margaret A. Lowrance has never remarried since the death of her husband, Miles A. Lowrance.
