 Lowrance applicant for pension
 herein and have known him since
 the year 1859. I first knew him in
 1859 in Kerr County Texas. I per-
 sonally know the said applicant
 J. S. Lowrance enlisted in the
 service of the Confederacy and
 performed the duties of a
 soldier in said service. I know
 that he was a soldier in Rice
 Company - McLanahan Regiment
 Company A I think - I saw him
 frequently in the army. I saw
 him as a soldier in said
 Army at Camp Davis - saw
 him often - saw him at Knoxville
 during the Confederate War -
 as a soldier in said Army -
 I know he never deserted the
 service in the Confederacy. I
 think he served all during the
 war as a soldier - he served
 during the entire war - he served
 in South and Southwest Texas

I know all I have testified to of
 my own personal knowledge
 and not from conjecture. I
 know the said J. S. Lowrance
 is unable to support himself
 by labor of any sort - I
 know of no other soldier of
 the same name as J. S. Lowrance
