SCHOOL PRINCIPAL LOSES HER ACTION

Verdict Returned Against Mrs. Nannie Harding, Suing Cradock Council

In the second trial of the action instituted by Mrs. Nannie Harding, former principal of the Cradock public school, against C. A. Barton and others, members of the Cradock Council, conducted in the Circuit Court of Norfolk County yesterday, a verdict in favor of the defendants was returned.

Mrs. Harding, who was dropped from the roll of the Cradock school as its principal about a year ago, sued the school authorities of the community for \$570 for salary. When the case was heard several months ago a verdict in favor of the plaintiff was returned. The award was set aside, however, and a new trial granted.

The defendants were represented yesterday by Attorneys Hornef and Hartman.
