NAMED HEAD OF CRADOCK SCHOOL J. S. Hudnall, of Northumberland County, Selected as Principal

J. S. Hudnall has been engaged as principal of the Cradock school during the session of 1922-23, which will open on September 18. Announcement of his selection for the position was made last night by Superintendent Hurst, division head of the county schools.

years, been principal of the schools in Northumberland County. Va. He is a graduate of Randolph-Macon College, and during the World War saw service overseas.

He will come here within a short time to make preparations for the opening of the school, where he will have a staff of about fifteen teachers in Cradock.

The school there is to be operated during the approaching session by Norfolk County, through an arrangement whereby fees will be collected from householders in the community for the maintenance of the institution.
