This John Vermilyea is most likely the son of John Vermilyea⁴, (John/Johannes/Honnes)³, John², Johannes¹) #64 Fourth Generation and his wife Geertruyd (Charity) House. This is based on the fact that there is a known connection to Rensselaerville as both John #64 and his brother Benjamin #65 are listed in the Van Rensselaer (Rensselaerwyck) Manor Papers, 1630-1899 records with land transactions from May 1790 through January 1799. Both brothers are next recorded living in 1800 at Unadilla, Otsego County, New York. John and Geertruyd are known to have more children than currently recorded. No records containing birth or death date can be located for John who married at Westerlo, Albany County, New York about 1818 Catherine Lawson. The death record of his son Andrew lists his parent's names and the fact he was born at Rensselaerville. John can't be located in any record after the article published in The Evening Journal in 1838, so no exact age can be determined. He and Catherine are not located on the 1850 census records though we know she was living at that time. No burial records can be located for either. We know she died in 1864 at Rotterdam however, no burial information. **(NEW INFORMATION HAS BEEN ADDED IN THIS FILE, SEE BELOW)**

John Vermilya (UNKNOWN) born between 1780 and 1790 in New York, married about 1818 at Westerlo, New York Catharine, daughter of Andrew and Anna (Brouwer) Lawson, earlier spelled Lossing) who was born July 1, 1787, baptized August 12, 1787 at New Hackensack Dutch Reformed Church, Wappingers Falls, New York, died July 7, 1864 at Rotterdam, New York. He died probably between 1840 and 1850. No record can be found of his death or burial. Source Code #725, Death Certificate of Andrew P. Vermilye and census records.

John Vermilyea of Rensselaerville is mentioned in an article titled Albany Whig County Convention. Representing Rensselaerville. Source: The Evening Journal, Albany, New York. Meeting October 8, 1838. He was a delegate from the town of Rensselaerville, appointed October 4, 1838 at the Rensselaerville meeting.

Information from the Death Certificate of Andrew P. Vermilye: born at Rensselaerville, New York. Date of birth not given, but he died in 1902 at the age of 81 years, 10 months and 11 days. Father: John Vermilye; Mother: Catharine Lawson. They were both born in New York State, John was a farmer.

No John Vermilya in Albany area in 1810, but there is an Andrew P. Lawson at Rensselaerville. In 1810 the only Vermilye-- listed in Albany, Rensselaerville is David 00201 20201. Andrew P. Vermilyea is listed in the Schenectady City and County Directory from 1860-1879. His occupation is carpenter.

Bath Daily Times, Friday, December 26, 1902, Vol 42, No. 302, page 8: The remains of the late Andrew P. Vermilye who died in Arrowsic last Tuesday were brought to this city yesterday for interment in Maple Grove Cemetery. The deceased was aged eighty-one years.
