Sadie D. Vermilye, (Parents unknown) born November 2, 1865 in Maryland, married in 1883 Charles Edwin Wonderly who was born May 2, 1852 in Maryland, died December 22, 1917 at Baltimore, Maryland. She died December 27, 1891 at Baltimore, Maryland. There is no Sadie Vermilye listed anyplace prior to 1880. Their sons have listed their mother's place of birth as Maryland consistently. Of course, they were so young when she died, they never knew her. Their father never remarried, and his sister helped him bring up the boys. W. Carey Wonderly To Be Buried Today

Funeral Services For Well-Known Author Will Be Conducted At His Home

Funeral services for W. Carey Wonderly, well-known author, who died suddenly from a heart attack on Monday, will be conducted at his home, 1537 North Fulton avenue, this morning at 10:30 o'clock, by the Rev. Paul H. Walenta, pastor of Fulton Avenue Presbyterian Church. Burial will be in Loudon Park Cemetery.

Mr. Wonderly, son of the late Charles E. and Sadie V. Wonderly, was born in Baltimore in 1886 and received his education in the public schools of this city.

At the age of 18 he began writing fiction, and since that time more than 400 of his stories have been accepted by magazine publishers. He is survived by two brothers; Robert C. and Charles E. Wonderly, both of this city.
