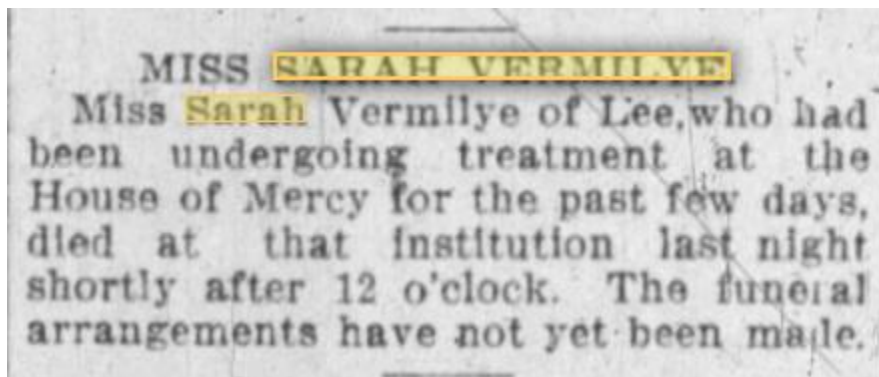

Sarah Ann Vermilye, (Parents unknown) born about August 1833 at Columbia, New York (Columbia, city or county ---- Columbia was a town formerly in Tompkins County, New York, also, town of Columbia in Herkimer County and there is also a Columbia County in New York??), died January 22, 1905 at Pittsfield, Massachusetts, burial in Pittsfield Cemetery, Pittsfield, Massachusetts. There are no Vermilye families listed in this cemetery at findagrave.com. There are Hubbard families listed in this cemetery, however there is no listing for a Homer Hubbard. There are several named Sarah Hubbard, but none identified as Sarah Wood Hubbard and none with her dates. Daniel and Tamson Hubbard who are listed on Homer's death record as his parents are listed in the Pittsfield Cemetery. Sarah Vermilye's parents are listed unknown on her death record. She was unmarried.

In 1850 she is living in the household of Homer Fowler Hubbard who was born about 1801 in Massachusetts, wife Sarah Hubbard, born about 1801 in New York, Sarah Vermilye is listed as age 17, born New York, Martin F. Mallisen, age 8, born in Massachusetts, May Wood, age 59, born Massachusetts and Robert Francis, no information given. On the 1880 Census record Sarah Vermilye is listed as niece of Homer.

Further records indicate that Sarah Hubbard died January 9, 1873 at Becket, Massachusetts, age 72 years, 11 months and 19 days, born about 1801 at Stephentown, New York. Her parents are listed as Amos and Mary Wood. Homer Fowler Hubbard was born December 5, 1800 at Pittsfield, Massachusetts, father Daniel Hubbard, mother is Tamson. Homer and Sarah Vermilye are listed on the 1880 Federal Census at Becket, Massachusetts, he is age 79, widower, farmer, she is listed age 45, niece, single, born New York, parents born New York, housekeeper. Homer's death is recorded in 1883 at Becket, Massachusetts at Ancestry.com. Massachusetts, U.S., Town and Vital Records, 1620-1988. No burial location is located for Homer and Sarah Hubbard. Sarah Vermilye is enumerated in Massachusetts in every census record from 1850 to 1900. In 1860 Sarah Vermilye is enumerated with the Whalen family at Becket, Massachusetts as a servant, born August 1836, born New York, parents born New York. There is no indication that she is related to the Whalen family.
