
## Old church steeped in heritage



A cemetery with many family names recognizable as Irish surrounds St. Mary's Catholic Church in the Town of Springvale. The church was built 125 years ago in 1858 by Irish settlers, many of whose decendents still attend Sunday Mass there. St. Mary's is a mission parish that has never had a resident pastor. The Rev. Eliot Comstock and the Rev. Robert St. Martin of St. Joseph's

Church in Waupun share the responsibil of serving the 23 member families of Mary's. The church has no heat, electric or plumbing and is only open from the fi Sunday in June until Labor Day weeke Parishioners attend St. Brendam's Catho Church in Brandon during the cold mon their parish is closed.
