

TIPS FOR TAKING THE BEST PICTURES OF CEMETERY STONES 27 May 2010

Take "View" Pictures of Cemetery too



Look for the Family Plot



Check ALL the SIDES of stones!



Check for FOOTSTONES!

Don't Forget: Check to see if stone needs to be DUG OUT!



CLEANING STONES can make them more readable!



Your Cemetery KIT: Leave it in the car & be ready to GO! and/or BAGE

Your Cemetery KIT:

Spray WATER Bottles

T Spade
O Plastic Scrapers
O Grass Clipper
L Knife/Saw to cut Sod
S -make your own?



Plastic Bristle Brushes

Your Cemetery KIT: Don't Forget a



<u>MRRORI</u>

Control the amount of light you want and the angle you want it to be

Watch the lettering just POP OUT!

Use only Use only Use only EVERTING ELSE ONCESSIONES to clean stones!!

no pressure Sprayers No mire Bristle Brushes No Metal Scrapers No Chalk/Shaving Cream +

LICHEN can hide important lettering BUT it CAN be removed!





Wet, Scrape, Wipe Repeat if necessary

CLEANING STONES of Lichen ONLY USING WATER!! SPRAY-LIBERALY (SOAKOELL)

SCRAPE off lichen-



Clean - then Take FULL View & CLOSE-UP pictures

CHECK SIDES & TOPS TOO!

Beginning a Cemetery Photo Survey..

Start at end of beginning ROW and work across Watch for Family Plots

Check ALL sides of Stones Service markers many times on back

CHECK SIDES & TOPS TOO!

NOT MUCH FUN TO DO BUT GREAT TO FIND THE STONE(S)!

FUNEW & COSC-Ups

Check BUSHES & TREES for Stones! Take FULL & CLOSE-UP pictures!

When Flowers+ Block Stones Take FULL & Close-up pictures!



At END of DAY's Work (if not finished) take "View"picture of where you will begin next time..


