PARKERSBURG, January 31.—To-day an application was made in the United States Court for a receiver for the West Virginia Oil and Land Company, but a demurrer was entered to the petition and was sustained.

The cases of Thomas Manifes for illegal voting and Wm. H. Lewis, of Wheeling, for voting before he became of age, were on trial to-day in the United States Court.

The case of Golden against Deem, originally for a small amount, is at last settled with a verdict for Deem of \$61.01. The costs and lawyers' fees amount to over one thousand dollars.
